Angry passenger gets his revenge.

Have you ever had a problem with an airline? Dave Carroll did, but he got his revenge. It all started with a trip on a United Airlines aeroplane. Musician Dave Carroll booked a flight from Halifax (Nova Scotia, Canada) to Omaha, Nebraska (USA), with a **1.**[_____] of plane at Chicago. Things seemed to be fine, but then half-way through the flight something happened. “We were sitting at the back of the plane with the band, and a woman who didn’t know we were musicians yells out, ‘Oh, my God! They’re throwing guitars outside’,” Carroll, 41, explained. On looking outside, Carroll could see baggage handlers **2.**[_____] the guitars into the air and letting them fall onto the baggage trolley. Carroll later discovered that his \$3,500 acoustic guitar was severely damaged, **3.**[_____] being in a hard case. Carroll asked the airline for compensation.
